### **IMF's outlook on Indian Economy**

- As per latest <u>World Economic Outlook</u>, released by International Monetary Fund (IMF), Indian economy is projected to grow 7.4% in the current fiscal i.e. FY 2018-19 and accelerate further in FY 2019-20 to 7.8%
- India's growth in current and next fiscal will come on back of strong private consumption as well as fading transitory effects of demonetisation (in November 2016) and roll out of Goods and Services Tax (in July 2017).
- **Consumer inflation is projected at 5%** for the current as well as next year while the **current account deficit is seen at 2.3%** of GDP this fiscal and 2.1% next fiscal.
- Global growth is seen stable at 3.9% over the current and next calendar years.

## CII projects FY19 GDP growth at 7.3-7.7 percent

- Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) projected <u>India's gross domestic</u> product (GDP) is expected to grow at 7.3-7.7 percent during the 2018-19 financial year
- The growth in 2018-19 will come on back of strong demand in the rural economy, including agriculture and non-farm activities, as well as better global growth climate.
- <u>Agriculture sector is expected to grow at 2.5-3.5 percent, industrial</u> <u>sector to grow at 7.2-7.5 percent and services sector to grow at 8.4-8.7</u> <u>percent</u>.

#### India's social sector spending remains woefully below peers: RBI bulletin

- The study *titled 'Union Budget 2018-19: An Assessment'* has been published in the latest RBI monthly bulletin.
- The Report analysed 17 countries, including India, with respect to their social sector expenditure as per cent of GDP 2016.
- India's social sector spending remains woefully below peers, including Latvia and Iceland, in terms of GDP.
- As per The study ,the expenditure on health and education together is budgeted to grow by 4.6 per cent as per the 2018-19 Budget.
- India's social sector expenditure as per cent of GDP in 2016 was **7.5 per cent** whereas it was 29 per cent in Belgium, 15.2 per cent in Iceland, 14.5 in Latvia and 10.4 per cent in Korea, among other countries.

## NABARD approves Rs 14,690 crore funding to Rajasthan

- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has <u>extended total credit support of Rs 14690 crore to Rajasthan during</u> 2017-18.
- Rajasthan has been **one of the biggest beneficiaries under the** <u>Rural</u> <u>Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) of NABARD.</u>
- Funds sanctioned by NABARD were used for 10 irrigation projects, construction of 1614 roads and two rural drinking water supply projects in the state.

# India slapped anti-dumping duty on import of phosphorus pentoxide from <u>China for five years</u>.

- The imposed anti-dumping duty of \$1,685.42 per metric tonne is to protect the domestic manufacturers from cheap shipments,.
- **Directorate General of Anti-Dumping and Allied Duties** found that the chemical was being exported to India <u>below the normal value</u>.

<u>Note:</u> Phosphorus Pentoxide is used as a powerful desiccant and dehydrating agent and is a useful building block and reagent in the chemical industry.

Anti-dumping measures are taken to ensure fair trade and provide a levelplaying field to the domestic industry. They are not a measure to restrict imports or cause an unjustified increase in cost of products.

**RInfra won Rs 1,081 crore contract for Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project** from Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd (NPCIL) for work in two units of the Kudankulam project in Tamil Nadu

- It is for Common Services System, Structure & Components (SSC) package and allied civil works of Unit -3 and 4 of the Kudankulam project at Tirunelveli District.
- This project will be commissioned in 56 months

### <u>60% of India's GDP to come from AI, other digital services by 2021:Microsoft</u> <u>Study</u>

As per Microsoft study- By the year 2021, around 60 per cent of the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is expected to be derived from digital products and services created through the use of technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), the Internet of Things and cloud computing, among others, It says *digital transformation will add an estimated \$154 billion to our GDP by 2021*.

#### **CENTRAL GOVT EFFORTS:** The central government has formed a **committee on AI to suggest a technical framework or platform for the emerging technology** chaired by **P P Chakraborty**, a professor at IIT, Kharagpur.

- Committee has representatives from Google, Microsoft, NVIDIA and TCS, from Nasscom, the apex association of the information technology (IT) sector, beside the National Informatics Centre and the ministry of electronics and IT.

#### Cashbacks launched on BHIM for users, merchants

• Merchants who accept payments through BHIM or other apps using the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) entitled to a *maximum cashback of Rs* 1,000 per month, they will receive a cashback worth 10% of the value of each transaction, subject to a cap of Rs 50 per transaction.

BHIM (Bharat Interface for Money) is a mobile app developed by National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), based on the Unified Payment Interface (UPI)

### India's global trade rises 16% to \$767.9 billion in 2017-18

- As per data released by Commerce Ministry, India's global trade in 2017-18 stood at \$767.9 billion. This marks an **increase by 16.32 per cent** as compared to \$660.2 billion in 2016-17.
- Bilateral trade with Latin American Countries (LAC) including Bolivia, Peru, Chile and Brazil has recorded healthy growth of 19.63 per cent in 2017-18.
- Out of all the above stated LACs, *India-Bolivia bilateral trade grew phenomenally at 205 per cent* from \$253 million in 2016-17 to \$772.44 million in 2017-18.

# **India's average GDP growth to rise to 7.8 pc in first half of this year: Nomura Report**

- According to the Japanese firm Nomura, India's average Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth is expected to rise to 7.8 per cent in the first half of 2018 & growth for Q4-2018 is forecasted at 6.9 per cent.
- As per Nomura, this **GDP growth in first half of 2018 will come on back** of increase in investments as well as consumption demand.

#### HRD Ministry Launched Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 in New Delhi

- <u>Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0</u> is a flagship programme of the Ministry of Human Resources Development.
- Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0, students from selected colleges and universities will go to nearby villages to get acquainted with the life of the village people and the problems faced by them in day to day life.
- Under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0, 750 reputed Higher Educational Institutes (both public and private) have been selected and faculty and students of each selected institute would adopt a cluster of villages/panchayats to undertake above stated activity.

#### Sovereign Gold Bonds Scheme was First announced in Union Budget 2015-16.

• The two objectives were- to reduce the demand of physical gold and thereby reduce the import bill and the funds deployed can be used for developmental projects in the country.

<u>Note:</u> Benefits includes <u>The stipulated interest</u> on the bonds .These bonds are highly liquid, eliminates the need for conducting quality check, , issued in paper form and can even be dematerialised.

## E-way bill rolled out on April 20, 2018 in six states

- Intra-State E-way (Electronic Way) bill i.e. the E-way bill for movement of goods within the state rolled out in six more states from April 20, 2018.
- Six states are <u>Bihar, Jharkhand, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Tripura</u> and Uttarakhand.
- E-way bill system for moving goods worth over Rs 50000 from one state to another has already been rolled out since April 1, 2018.
- Karnataka is the only state which had rolled out Intra-State E-way bill system from April 1, 2018.
- After that, Intra-State E-way bill system was rolled out in five states viz.
  Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Gujarat, Kerala and Uttar Pradesh from April 15, 2018.

<u>Note</u>: E-way bill provision of the GST is an anti-evasion measure which would help in increasing tax collections by curbing trade that is being undertaken on cash basis.

#### POSHAN Abhiyaan: 1st meeting of National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges held in New delhi

- The Abhiyaan <u>aims to reduce the level of **under-nutrition and stunting**, **under-nutrition, anemia** (among young children, women and adolescent girls) <u>and reduce low birth weight by 2%, 2%, 3% and 2% per annum</u> <u>respectively.</u></u>
- The Abhiyaan targets to reduce The target of the mission is to bring down stunting among children in the age group 0-6 years from 38.4% to 25% by 2022.
- POSHAN Abhiyaan was launched on 8th March 2018 by the Prime Minister in Jhunjhunu.

Note: Stunting is defined as the percentage of children, aged 0 to 59 months, whose height for age is below minus two standard deviations (moderate and severe stunting) and minus three standard deviations (severe stunting) from the median of the WHO Child Growth Standards.

• In India, 38 per cent of children younger than five years of age are stunted, a manifestation of chronic undernutrition.

## **Indian economy has recovered from impact of demonetisation, GST: World Bank Report**

- As per <u>World Bank's bi-annual South Asia Economic Focus report</u> released on April 15, 2018, Indian economy has recovered from the adverse impacts of demonetisation (in November 2016) and roll out of Goods and Services Tax (in July 2017).
- Indian economy is projected to grow by 7.3% in 2018 and 7.5% in 2019.
- Indian recovery will again make South Asia region- projected to grow at 6.9% in 2018 and 7.1% in 2019, the world's fastest growing region.

### WPI inflation reached at 2.47 % in March

- As per Ministry of Commerce & Industry data -<u>India's annual</u> <u>Wholesale Price Inflation (WPI) was at 2.47 % in March 2018</u>, a ninemonth low, due to a fall in price of vegetables and other food and beverages.
- WPI reflects the change in average prices for bulk sale of commodities at the first stage of transaction.
- The new series of Wholesale Price Index(WPI) are with base 2011-12.

## YES Bank launched YES GST facility for MSMEs

• Yes Bank has launched 'Yes GST', an OD (over draft) facility for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).

# Centre' to boost farmers' solar power use- KUSUM scheme

- Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahaabhiyan or KUSUM scheme aims to incentivise farmers to run solar farm water pumps and use barren land for generating solar power to have extra income.
- It would provide extra income to farmers, by giving them an option to sell additional power to the grid through solar power projects set up on their barren lands
- The total cost of the capacities under this scheme would be Rs 1.4 lakh crore. The Centre will provide Rs 48,000 crore financial assistance under the scheme.
- MCA (Ministry of Corporate Affairs)zeroed in on 225,000 more suspected shell companies after taking action against 226,000 shell companies last year.
- Of the 226,000 companies, bank details of 168,000 had been revealed. Of those, 73,000 companies deposited Rs 240 billion in banks post-demonetisation.

**Note:** Under the Companies Act, 2013, companies can be struck off the register if they do not file financial returns for a continuous period of three years.

# World Bank group approved massive USD 13 billion increase in paid-in capital

- The package approved by the Development Committee of the Board of Governors consists <u>of 7.5 billion dollars paid-in capital</u> for <u>International</u> <u>Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD)</u> and <u>5.5 billion</u> <u>dollars paid-in capital for International Finance Commission (IFC).</u>
- The package also includes a 52.6 billion dollars callable capital increase for the IBRD.
- The boost in capital will be augmented by a **broad range of internal** measures, including operational changes and effectiveness reforms, loan pricing measures, and other policy steps to create an even stronger World Bank Group.

# **<u>RBI made Aadhaar key to KYC compliance</u>**

- Reserve Bank of India amended its 'know your customer' (KYC) guidelines, making Aadhaar mandatory for conducting customer due diligence by banks and finance companies.
- As every citizen is eligible for Aadhaar, **the rule will apply to all Indians.**
- The mandatory Aadhaar norm will not apply to residents of Jammu and Kashmir, Assam and Meghalaya.
- However, any change in norms, will be subject to a final decision by the Supreme Court on matters related to Aadhaar.

## India's growth expected to expand at 7.4 % in 2017-18: RBI Governor

- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Urjit Patel has stated that India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is expected to grow at 7.4% in 2018-19.
- Global demand has been improving, which should encourage exports and boost fresh investments in 2018-19.
- Gross fiscal deficit (GFD) of the Central Government is budgeted at 3.3 per cent in 2018-19.

- United Nations (UN) has launched a UN Road Safety Trust Fund to spur action that could save lives and prevent the loss of opportunity associated with road accidents.
- The fund has been launched in wake of tragic road accidents in Canada and India.
- UN Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) is the secretariat for the trust fund.
- Usage of the fund will be in accordance *with five pillars of the Global Plan for the Decade of Action for Road Safety.*
- 1. Strengthened road safety management capacities,
- 2. Enhanced safety of vehicles,
- 3. Improved safety of road infrastructure and
- 4. Broader transport networks,
- 5. Improved behaviour of road users and improved post-crash care.

UN General Assembly also adopted a resolution on road safety, calling for a range of measures to prevent road accidents and to minimise the resulting damage. This resolution was sponsored by Russia.

- Singapore and China signed a MoU in Beijing to promote greater collaboration between Singapore and Chinese companies in third-party markets along the Belt and Road initiative.
- As per the terms of the MoU ,Singapore's Ministry of Trade and Industry (MTI) and NDRC (China's lead agency for BRI) will form a working group to identify sectors and markets of mutual interest, and organise business matching activities and forums to facilitate third-party market cooperation between Singapore and Chinese companies along the Belt and Road.

**Belt and Road initiative** is a strategic developmental project proposed by Chinese president Xi Jinping ,**Aimed to connect China with Eurasia through land-based "Silk Road Economic Belt" (SREB) and ocean going "Maritime Silk Road"** (MSR).

## **NATIONAL**

- Govt rolled out an 'Integrated initiative for prevention & control of viral hepatitis' with a budget of more than 517 crore rupees for three years.
- Components such as surveillance, awareness generation, immunisation, safe blood, injection safety infection control, diagnosis of viral hepatitis, capacity building, research and monitoring would be addressed under the initiative.
- Under the initiative, the <u>ministry intends to scale up to 100 treatment and</u> 665 testing centres over a period of next three years in all states.
- *Viral hepatitis* is *liver inflammation* due to a viral infection and it is recognised as a public health problem worldwide.

- New class of antibiotics Odilorhabdins were discovered which can help in fighting drug-resistant or hard-to-treat bacterial infections.
- ODLs, are developed by symbiotic bacteria present in soil-dwelling nematode worms that colonise insects for food.
- The bacteria helps to kill the insect and secretes the antibiotic to keep competing bacteria away. When ODL is bound to ribosome, <u>it disrupts its</u> <u>ability to interpret and translate genetic code.</u>
- Health Ministry has banned over-the-counter sale of 14 steroid skin creams
- This ban has been imposed in response to dermatologists' campaign against these skin creams and ointments containing steroids.
- <u>steroid based ointments</u> are dangerous and cause fungal epidemic in India.
- Note : Now, these creams can be <u>bought using doctor's prescription</u> <u>only</u>. The ban is based on recommendations of the Drug and Technical Advisory Board (DTAB) under the Drug Controller General of India.

- SpaceX blasted off NASA's new planet-hunter spacecraft TESS (Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite) on board a SpaceX Falcon 9.
- Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS): is a \$337 million satellite.
- TESS is expected to find 20,000 planets beyond our solar system.
- TESS will focus on nearby exoplanets in the range of 30 to 300 light-years away.

TESS will spend two months moving into the correct orbit. Its first scientific data will be sent in July 2018.
