### PNB Fraud amounted to 11,400 crore:

A set of bank officials of Punjab National Bank (**PNB**) in connivance with jewellery merchant **Nirav Modi** have defrauded around **Rs 11,345 crore** or **\$ 1.8 bn**.

#### What is the fraud about?

They used **fake PNB guarantees** to secure loan from overseas branches of Indian banks. They claimed showing these guarantees that they needed cash to import pearls.

This fraud started in 2011 when a senior PNB official in Mumbai branch started issuing such fake guarantees or undertakings. They used the SWIFT messages to avoid internal detection. When the employee involved retired in 2017, the scam gradually came to light.

Many **other banks** such as Axis bank and Allahabad banks too **are affected** as they were approached by these fraudsters to get loans in cash.

PNB has filed a case in this regard with CBI and Government too has asked all banks to send reports involving this case or other such incidents latest by the end of this week.



• India Signed Second Loan Agreement with **New Development Bank** (NDB) for USD **100 Million** for Rajasthan Water Sector Restructuring Project for Desert Areas.

• **Objective of this Project**- rehabilitate the 678 km long **Indira Gandhi Canal** system built during 1958-63 to prevent seepage, conserve water, and enhance water use efficiency.

• It is a multilateral development bank (like World Bank or Asian Development Bank) established by **BRICS nations** (**B**razil, **R**ussia, **I**ndia, **C**hina, **S**outh Africa).

**Department of Heavy Industry** has formulated the final draft of National Automobile Policy for holistic development of automobile sector in India.


#### Salient features:

- Adopt a long-term roadmap for emission standards beyond **BSVI** (Bharat Stage 6 which will come into effect from 2020)
- Roll out CAFÉ norms till 2025 and set up incentives/penalties.
- For tax purposes, vehicles should be classified based on length and CO2 emission

• Harmonize AIS (Automotive Industry Standard) and BIS (Bureau of Indian standard) on safety critical parts over next 3 years

- Scale-up of indigenous R&D with commercially viable innovations
- Fast track adoption of Bharat New Vehicle Safety Assessment Program

#### What is CAFÉ norm?



Corporate Average Fuel **Economy** (CAFE) norms to improve the average fuel efficiency of cars. They were first introduced in USA after the Arab oil embargo of 1973-74.

#### What is Bharat Stage norm?

BS norms or Bharat Stage Emission norms are emission standards adopted by Government of India to regulate pollution from motor vehicles. Based on Euro norms, it was first introduced in 2000 as BS- 1 and progressively more stringent norms have been introduced.

From April, 2017 BS- 4 has been implemented all across India.

The government has already decided to jump directly to **BS-6** from BS-4 from 2020.

## NPCI accorded consent to roll out Whatsapp BHIM UPI Beta Launch:


• NPCI (National Payment Corporation of India) has given its consent to roll out WhatsApp BHIM UPI beta launch. It is a payment app by whatsapp.

- But with a **limited user base of 1 million** and low per-transaction limit. Full feature product will be released once the beta test is successful.
- It will work on **multi-bank model**. Four banks will join the multi-bank BHIM UPI model in phases. It helps **distribution of transaction load** and **integrate popular apps** easily.
- NPCI said it will allow the full-scale public launch of any Unified Payments Interface (UPI)-enabled app only if the app fulfils the principles of interoperability.

#### What is NPCI?

National Payment Corporation of India (NPCI) is an umbrella organization for all retail payment systems in India set up in 2008 as a not-for-profit organisation registered under section 8 of the Companies Act 2013.

• NABARD announced area development plans worth **Rs 1,918 crore** for **Punjab** to supplement farmers' income.

• Under this plan, the activities like dairy, vegetable cultivation, bee keeping, and mushroom growing will be promoted.

## Bajaj Finserv's Sanjiv Bajaj named EY entrepreneur of the year:





## PNB arm, IFC tied up to raise \$800 mn for affordable housing:

• **PNB Housing Finance Ltd** has tied up with **International Finance Corporation** (IFC) to raise \$800 million for **green and affordable housing** in India.

• **IFC** is an international finance institution and a part of **World Bank Group** which encourages **private investment in developing countries** and PNB Housing Finance Ltd is a **subsidiary of Punjab National Bank** (PNB).

- Out of **\$ 800 mn**, IFC will bring in **\$** 400 mn and the rest will come from IFC.
- PNB Housing will issue Masala Bonds to raise their money.

#### What is Masala bond?

These are rupee denominated bonds issued outside India to raise capital overseas.

When such rupee denominated bonds are **issued in India**, these are called **Maharaja bonds**.


*IFC was the first* to launch masala bonds in **2014** to raise **1,000 crore** for infrastructure projects in India.

**HDFC became the first Indian company** in 2016 to issue masala bond to raise 3,000 crore.

NTPC launched first corporate green masala bond in 2016.

### No reservation chart on train from 1st March:

• The Ministry of Railways has instructed all rail zones to discontinue pasting reservation charts on reserved coaches of all trains from 1st March, launched as a pilot project at all A1, A and B category stations (categorized based on revenue).

• Instead digital charts will be displayed where chart plasma system has been installed.

• In 2016, Indian Railways had launched a no-reservation chart concept at Bengaluru City and Yeshwantpur railway stations which helped Railway save 60 lakh rupees.

## Fairfax to acquire 51% stake in Catholic Syrian Bank:

- Fairfax Holdings Ltd will buy 51% stake in Catholic Syrian Bank (CSB).
- It is the first ever takeover of a bank by a foreign institution.
- It is a deal of around **Rs 12, 000 crore**.

• Fairfax is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Canadian billionaire Prem Watsaowned Fairfax Financial Holdings.

## Nasscom expectED marginally higher IT export revenue growth:



• Software industry lobby **Nasscom** projected revenue growth of **7-9%** for the industry in FY19.

• On the sidelines of the ongoing **World IT Congress in Hyderabad** on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb, NASSCOM **President R. Chandrasekhar** said, the digital industry is growing at a fast **pace of 30%**.

- **Start-ups** sector grew by **25-30** % with 700 more start-ups coming into being.



• This is the first time India is hosting a World IT Congress and second time the event is taking place in Asia after Kualalumpur (Malaysia) in 2008.

• World IT Congress is **a biennial event** (in every two years) which provides a common platform to all stake holders of the IT industry.

## IWAI engaged KPMG as consultant for Jal Marg Vikas Project:

• The Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) has engaged **KPMG** for asset management and market development for Jal Marg Vikas Project. The project is also called **National Water Way-1** providing inland river connectivity in river Ganga.

• The projected is implemented with the help of World Bank.

## Cabinet approves auction methodology of coal mines to private players:

• The **Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA)** has approved methodology for auction of coal mines to private sector

• It will now allow commercial coal mining by private sector.

• Earlier Coal India Limited (CIL) had a monopoly over coal production and private players could be allotted coal block only for installing integrated power plant (that supplies electricity to their plant) not for commercial production.

• Necessary changes will be brought in the Coal Mines (Special Provision Act) 2015 and <u>Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation Act) 1957</u>.

## Cabinet approval for India-Morocco Cooperation Agreement in Railway sector:


• The Union Cabinet has approved a railway cooperation agreement with Morocco National Railway Office (MNRO) to enable technical cooperation, expert mission, exchange of staffs and personnel etc.

## Transmission charge waiver to solar and wind energy till 2022:

• The Union Power Ministry has extended waiver of **Inter-state power transmission charge** for **solar and wind energy** projects commissioned till 31st March, **2022.** The waiver will be available for 25 years from the date of commissioning provided developers sign power purchase agreement with entities.

Background:

India has an ambitious target of producing **175 GW** renewable energy by **2022**. It comprises of **100 GW solar energy**, **60 GW wind energy**, **10 GW from bio-mass** and **5 GW from small hydro projects**. As per **Paris Pledge**, India has committed to increase the **share of non-fossil fuel** to **40% by 2030**.

## RBI's Malegam panel to look into NPA issue and bank fraud:

• RBI has constituted and expert panel under former RBI board member Y H Malegam. Other members- Bharat Doshi (member of the RBI board); S Raman (former chairman and MD of Canara Bank and former whole-time member of SEBI); and Nandkumar Saravade. A K Misra is the member Secretary.

• **Purpose**- examine the rising incidence of fraud and its remedy,


**divergence** in asset classification (regarding **bad loans**) as reported by bank and the auditors.

• Background- the **PNB fraud** amounting to **11,400 crore** by misusing the **SWIFT**.

#### What is SWIFT?

It stands for the Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunications.

It is an **international messaging network** used by financial institutions to securely transmit information and instruction. A **unique code** is assigned to each financial organization consisting or **8 or 11 characters**. First four characters are institute code, next two are country code, and next two are city/location code. Last three are optional but often assigned to branches.



### Capital First got NHB approval for merger with IDFC bank:

• National Housing Bank (NHB) has allowed the merger of Capital First with IDFC bank, merger will create a combined entity of 88,000 crore.

• The share swap ratio for the merger is fixed at 139:10, meaning IDFC Bank will issue 139 shares for every 10 shares of Capital First.

• Currently, private equity firm Warburg Pincus holds 35.97 per cent in Capital First.

## Agriculture ministry added six new features in e-NAM platform:

• The agriculture ministry has added **six new features** in the National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) platform to make it more user friendly.

• These are: MIS (Management Information System) dashboard for better analysis, BHIM payment facility by traders, mobile payment facility by traders, enhanced features on mobile app such as gate entry and payment through mobile, integration of farmer's database and eLearning module in e-NAM website.

• e- NAM was launched in 2016 to provide **competitive and better price to farmers** through online competitive bidding of their products. Now real time bidding process, bidding price etc will be visible.

## **Cabinet approval for National Urban Housing Fund:**

• Union Cabinet has approved the creation of **Rs 60,000 crore National Urban Housing Fund (NUHF)** to fund Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna (Urban), aims to build **1.2 crore affordable houses in urban areas by 2022**.



• NUHF will be under Building Materials and Technology Promotion Council (BMTPC). It will facilitate raising capital to plug in shortfall in budget allocation.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna (Urban):

It is a part of the vision of 'Housing for all by 2022'. It aims at providing houses to all urban poor by constructing 2 crore houses across India. Beneficiaries are: BPL people, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and Low Income Group (LIG), Middle Income Group (MIG).

ANC is ruling party of South Africa after the end of apartheid and white minority rule in 1994.





- Women in Saudi Arabia can now <u>open their own businesses without the</u> <u>consent of a husband or male relative.</u> The kingdom has also opened 140 positions for women at airports and border crossings for the first time in its history.
- Tropical Cyclone Kelvin hit the north coast of Western Australia and another tropical cyclone Gita devastated Tonga, a small island in South Pacific to the East of Australia.
- 54th edition of annual Munich Security' Conference concluded in the German city of Munich, began on 16th February and continued till 18th February.


Discussions on various international security issues were held like Syrian Civil war, North Korean missile crisis etc. and nearly 30 Heads of the states and 100 Cabinet ministers participated in the conference.

• Saudi Arabia will hold its first ever Arab Fashion Week in Riyadh in March, from March 26 to March 31, with a second edition already scheduled for October.

In the past, Arab Fashion Week has been hosted so far exclusively by Dubai. Saudi Arabia has taken several such progressive measures in recent past under the guidance of Crown Prince Mohammed Bin Salman. Some of them are: **reopening of movie theatres, allowing women to drive, allowing women to open business without permission of male guardians** etc.

• The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) has warned that Pakistan is home to the highest newborn mortality rates in the world with 45 newborn babies dying out of every 1,000 births in 2016, Pakistan tops the list in IMR.

The report said newborn mortality rate in the Central African Republic was 42 newborn deaths, followed by Afghanistan with 40 and Somalia with 38. Japan's newborn mortality rate was among the lowest in the world, with 0.9 death for every 1,000 live births.

## Cauvery Water Dispute: SC awarded additional water to Karnataka

• Supreme Court has awarded an **additional 14.75 TMC** of **Cauvery water** to **Karnataka** and <u>reduced Tamil Nadu's share</u>, **upheld the 2007 decision** of **Cauvery Water Tribunal**, while making some amendments

• In its verdict, the apex court has granted the **global status to** Karnataka's capital city of **Bangalore**; hence it will get more Cauvery river water.

• The apex court has kept water share of Puducherry and Kerala unchanged.

• Judgement was pronounced by a bench comprising **Chief Justice Dipak Misra** and Justices Amitava Roy and A M Khanwilkar.

#### Cauvery Water Dispute-

#### States involved- Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Puducherry


To resolve the dispute, Government of India constituted a **tribunal in 1990** which gave its verdict in 2007. But being unsatisfied with the judgement, all the four states filed review petition with the Supreme Court.

### Centre to set up 562 more EMRS in tribal areas:

• The Centre will set up **562 more Eklavya Model Residential Schools** (EMRS) in tribal areas of the country as announced in the Budget that by the year **2022**, every block with at least 20 thousand tribal persons, will have an Eklavya School.

• EMRS provide boarding and lodging facilities to tribal students and will be brought at par with the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyala through high quality education.

• The Tribal Affairs Ministry has been allocated an amount of six thousand crore rupees in this Budget as compared to over 5329 crores rupees in 2017-18.



## <u>Candidates must reveal their source of income for</u> <u>contesting election, rules SC</u>

- The Supreme Court has ordered that candidates contesting elections will have to declare their sources of income as well as that of spouses and dependents.
- A bench of Justices J Chelameswar and S Abdul Nazeer issued the direction to make it mandatory for candidates.

• At present the Representation of the People Act, 1951, mandated the declaration of assets by candidates contesting elections but not the source of their income.

## Sex ratio at birth falls in 17 large states, Gujarat tops list:

• The **sex ratio at birth (SRB**) saw a <u>decline in 17 out of 21 large states</u> of the country as per a report by NITI Aayog.


• **Gujarat is the worst performing** state with a fall of 53 points in sex ratio at birth. It fell from 907 to 854 females per 1000 males, **followed by Haryana and Rajasthan**.

• This indicates **rampant sex-selective abortion** violating the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (**PCPNDT**) Act, 1994.

## India Fell 16 Spots On Globalisation Index Over 11 Years:

• In the **Globalisation Index**, India has fallen **16 spots from 78th to 62nd** in 2015 over 11 years - **second-worst change** among the comparable 16 countries which included BRICS and other emerging economies.

• The Global Connectedness Index 2016 was released in 2016 and was the 4th edition of the report.



## Clean Air Campaign to improve air quality in Delhi:

• The first week of Clean Air Campaign (joint effort of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Delhi Government) to curb air pollution in Delhi concluded, which began on 10th Feb and continued till 23<sup>rd</sup> Feb.

• **70 small teams** consisting of government officials, experts, activists etc visit random places to check pollution.

• The System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting and Research (**SAFAR**) has projected that the Clean Air Campaign has resulted in significant reduction in the level of air pollution.

## Canadian PM attended Canada-India Business Forum in Mumbai:

• Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau visited Mumbai on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb as part of his week-long visit to India and attended Canada - India Business Forum and also meet film personalities.

## Cabinet nod for Mahanadi Water Dispute Tribunal:


• Cabinet approved the proposal for constitution of **Mahanadi Water Disputes Tribunal** on **request from Odisha to** determine water sharing among basin states i.e. Odisha, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand.

#### What is the dispute all about?

**Chhattisgarh** plans to build **13 barrages and seven pick up weirs** (small dams) across Mahanadi river to extract more water. Odisha is opposed to it since it would decrease water supply to the farmers of its own state. Mahanadi is the largest river of Odisha.

**Centre's stand-** As per an **agreement in 1983** between Madhya Pradesh (then Chhatishgarh was part of MP) and Odisha there exists a mechanism to resolve the issue. And concerned states must negotiate among themselves.

**States' stand-** Odisha is strictly opposed to any negotiation and took the matter to Supreme Court in 2016. Since it believes there is nothing to negotiate and an independent tribunal can solve the issue.



*Court's stand-* In 2017 Supreme Court ordered the centre to form a tribunal under *Inter State River Water Dispute Act of 1956.* 

## Cabinet cleared introduction of Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Bill:

• To protect the savings of the investors, the Cabinet has given its approval to introduce two bills in Parliament.

- 1) The **Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Bill, 2018** aimed at tackling the menace of illicit deposit-taking activities in the country.
- 2) **The Chit Funds (Amendment) Bill, 2018** has been approved in order to facilitate the orderly growth of the Chit Funds sector and remove bottlenecks being faced by the Chit Funds industry.



• India **12th worst** among 52 lower middle-income nations for new born as per a UNICEF report with a rate of **25.4** ranks below Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal and Bhutan

• **New Born Mortality rate** refers to the number of deaths per 1,000 live births.

• Japan tops the list followed by Iceland and Singapore and Pakistan is the worst performing country followed by Central African Republic and Afghanistan

## Cabinet approved Silkyara Bend-Barkot Tunnel in Uttarakhand:

- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by the Prime Minister has approved the **construction of 4.531 km** long 2-Lane Bi-Directional **Silkyara Bend - Barkot Tunnel** will be built under Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Mode with a cost of **Rs 1383 crore in 4 years**.
- The project will be falling along **NH-134** (old NH-94) in the State of **Uttarakhand**.
- It is a part of ambitious Chardham plan by government providing all weather connectivity to Yamunotri

#### What is Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) model?

It is a type of Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) model. In this the private contractor takes most of the responsibility like design, procurement, construction and then hand over to government.

• The Parliament House will soon have a **crèche facility** for women employees as per the provision of **Maternity Benefit (amendment) Act of 2017.** 

## N Gopalaswamy Committee to select 20 'Institute of Eminence':

• <u>Former chief election commissioner</u> **N Gopalaswamy** has been appointed chairperson of the **empowered expert committee (EEC)**, having the final authority to **select 20 'Institute of Eminence'**.



• The four member panel includes: Renu khator, R Pritam Singh, Tarun Khanna

• The panel will <u>review the institutes once every three years</u> for adherence to their implementation plan until they achieve the top 100 global ranking slot for two consecutive years.

• And the institutes will have to inform the EEC every year about their progress and may be asked to address deficiencies or face penal action if they fail to deliver

#### What is Institute of Eminence?

• **10 public and 10 private Institutions** to emerge as world class teaching institutions or Institute of Eminence to <u>improve the ranking of Indian universities</u> in world ranking.

• **Dr Jitendra Singh**, MoS of **Department of Space** said ISRO is planning to launch Chandrayan-2 Mission around April this year.

• **Chandraayan-2** is a challenging mission as for the first time it will carry an obiter, a lender and a rover to the moon. The total cost of the Chandrayaan 2 mission will be about Rs 800 crore.


### AOCC inaugurated at Goa airport in Dabolim:

• The **Airport Operations Control Centre, AOCC**, was inaugurated at Goa airport in Dabolim with this, Goa airport became the **12th AAI-managed airport** with AOCC facility.

• The AOCC would help provide real-time information on flights operating at the airport on flight information displays.

## ONGC introduced Asia's first large scale CO2 injection technique:

• Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (**ONGC**) introduced Carbon Dioxide (**CO2**) injection technique in its **Gandhar oil field** in Gujarat, first large scale CO2 injected project in Asia. It increases extraction of oil.



• Its purpose is to recover extra 20 mn barrels of crude oil under **Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR)** programme aims at recovering up to 20% of residual oil from ageing oil field.

## Mumbai to have India's first Artificial Intelligence Centre:

• Maharashtra Government will set up country's first Institute for Artificial Intelligence in Mumbai and Maharashtra is already the first state to launch a FinTech policy.

• CM Devendra Fadnavis unveiled the plan for the institute during the Magnetic Maharashtra Summit inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on February 18, and at the Global Economic Conference in Canada next mon

• The State is already experimenting with AI in the health sector to use AI based X-ray, MRI and CT scan.


## New antibiotic found in soil to fight superbugs:

- A team of US scientist have discovered 'malacidin' which is a new kind of anti-biotic capable of killing drug resistant bacteria.
- With growing use of anti-biotic, many bacteria gradually evolve to develop an immunity towards anti-biotic. This creates hurdle in treatment and enhance mortality.
- This new anti-biotic however works only against certain kind of bacteria known as Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA).

## India successfully test-fires Agni-II ballistic missile:

• India's surface-to-surface Agni-II ballistic missile was test-fired successfully from the Abdul Kalam Island, off the Orissa coast.

• It is a **nuclear capable medium range ballistic missile (MRBM)** developed by **DRDO** (Defence Research and Development Organization) under Integrated Guided Missile Development Program.



### SARAS completes second test flight completely:

• India's **indigenous** (built in India) **light transport aircraft SARAS PT1N** was successfully test flown for a second time. This is the 2nd of the 20 planned test flights. First test was conducted in January.

• Designed and developed by- National Aerospace Laboratories of CSIR in Bangalore.

• With more than **70% indigenous content** it will be around **25% cheaper** than imported ones.

### India 7th most targeted nation for web application attacks:

• As per a report by Akamai, India was the victim of the **seventh most number** (11.5 mn) of web application attacks in the last quarter of 2017 and also the source of the seventh most number of web application attacks in the same quarter.

• In Asia-Pacific, India was the second biggest source of web application attacks just behind China.


• Globally, the top spot for most attacked and source for the most attacks was held by the USA.

• Netherland, China, Brazil and Russia also figure in top 5 in source of attack.

- Madhya Pradesh's first butterfly park has come up in Raise district housing around 65 species of colourful insects. Apart from providing a congenial atmosphere for breeding of butterflies, nearly 137 plant varieties are also part of the park spread over three hectares.
- In Gujarat, Air Odisha launched its maiden flight under the Centre's UDAN scheme, linking Mundra with Ahmadabad. Air Odisha is starting services from Ahmadabad to Jamnagar, Mundra and Diu in the first phase of its operation. (Total 400 Airports will be connected under this scheme out of which ten airports are from Gujarat).

#### What is UDAN scheme?

UDAN or **Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik** is a **Regional Connectivity Scheme** that provides **cheaper air transport** and <u>development smaller airports</u>. It is a market based mechanism under which private aircrafts provide quota in seats that are sold at subsidies price. This price is paid back to them by Government.


 Maharashtra Government will roll out Ashmita Yojna on International Women's Day (8th March). Under this, girls in Zill Parishad School will get sanitary napkin packet at Rs 5 and rural women can get it at subsidized rate of Rs 24 & 29.

Beneficiaries will be **given Ashmita Cards and** Supply and sale will be entrusted with Self Help Groups (SHG).

- West Bengal Government will sell government stock securities for a 10 year period to get an amount of **2,000 crore** through Reserve Bank of India. The proceeds of the loan will be utilised towards meeting the requirement for developmental expenditure of the state.
- Assam is at the bottom with regard to maternal mortality rate (MMR) with a figure of 300 against the national average of 167. It has spent just 13.58% of funding under National Health Mission (NHM).

The declining rate of MMR in the state, however, is the highest in country.

The **Infant Mortality Rate (IMR)** too is very high at 44 whereas the national average is 37.

- UP unveils new ambitious tourism policy:
- 1. UP Government announced a new tourism policy to increase tourist arrival and also investment in tourism sector.
- 2. The Government envisages the number of foreign tourists by 10 per cent and domestic arrivals by 15 per cent.
- 3. State govt aims at attracting investment of 5000 crore every year.

A centre For Agriculture with the collaboration of Israel will be opened in Mizoram on 7th March, exclusively for processing of citrus fruits set up at a cost of 8-10 crore.

## Collaboration of Govt of Israel, Govt of Mizoram and Ministry of Agriculture of Govt of India.

This is the first such centre in North East although there are 22 such centres in India with the first one was established in 2008 in Haryana.

Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** inaugurated **Uttar Pradesh Investors' Summit 2018** in Lucknow on 20th February. This is the <u>first time such</u> <u>summit is organized in UP</u> to showcase the investment potential of the state and to draw investment.

Around 1045 agreement worth **Rs 4.28 lakh crore** has been signed in the first day of the summit.

- The Indian Railways signed a MoU with the Maharashtra government to set up a **metro coach factory in Latur** with an investment of **Rs600 crore to** manufacture metro coaches with a potential of exporting them to the other countries and generation of **15,000 direct jobs** in backward region of Marathwada.
- Kerala Government approved the draft State Health Policy to ensure 100% immunization in Kerala. It has made <u>vaccination certificate</u> mandatory for admission to class-I from the next academic session.

It has also suggested strict legal action against people trying to discourage parents about vaccinating their children.

• Uttar Pradesh's Khadi and Village Industry Board signed a MoU with Amazon India for online selling of khadi products. Amazon India will educate and train rural khadi artisans of UP to directly sell their products to Amazon.
